Choose a time "slice" and read down to see what scheduled events are occurring simultaneously.  
Come down to the site to discover off-the-schedule events as well.

When you arrive, you will find maps and guides to help you find your event location.

Dotted lines indicate ongoing, 24-hour events. Solid colors indicate individual events.

The titles for each event are a kind of mysterious shorthand; they are meant to be provocative.

Here are explanations for a FEW of them. Come take a chance on the rest.

**24-HOUR EVENTS (A Sampling)**

**Drone Quartet** (Music): A continuous, live structured improvisation with wind instruments that weaves into the natural and man-made sounds present at the site.

**Knowledge Transfer:** Guides that will greet you at the bridge and point you in the right direction.

**The Follies:** Not-quite-random acts of focused whimsy created and enacted by the folly team.

**7AM**

**Sluice Duet** (Physical Systems/Dance): A duet inspired by sluiceways cut into the river by William de La Barre.

**8AM**

**Lock Ensemble** (Music): A boat filled with musicians playing wind instruments will navigate through the St. Anthony Locks.

**10AM**

**Word Hill** (Folly): Words magically appearing and disappearing on the West Bank of the Mississippi River.

**12 NOON**

**Sky Procession** (Community Action) Hundreds of people carry pieces of sky to the center of the bridge to create a "sky pile".

**2PM**

**Guided Performance Tours:** 3 different tours exploring the history of this place through surprising performance and installation.

**3PM**

**Walks with Experts:** small group walks with experts on Labor and Transit, Trees of the area, Architecture and much more.

**4PM**

**The Great Cake Contest:** Cakes that represent one of nine historic moments in the life of St. Anthony Falls.

**12:30PM**

**Flour Printing:** Fleeting flour images created on the surface of the bridge.

**1AM**

**Endurance Duet:** Choreography that takes three hours to cross the bridge.

**4AM**

**Silent Procession:** A slow, silent group walk across the bridge; all are welcome.

**7AM**

**Breakfast Banquet:** Community continental breakfast on the East or West Bank of the river.
